

Imperfect Middle/Passive Indicative

	Sing.	Pl.
1	ἐλύομην	-όμεθα
2	-ου	-εσθε
3	-ετο	-οντο

- ✓ Secondary tenses mid/pass endings: -μην, -σο, -το, -μεθα, -στε, -ντο
- ✓ *Augment* is added to the secondary tenses. It is usually an epsilon (ἐ-) before a consonant; alpha/epsilon becomes eta (ἦ) and omicron becomes omega (ὦ).

Imperfect mid/pass indicative inflection of λύω and its meaning

ἐλύομην	I was being loosened
ἐλύου	you (s.) were being loosened
ἐλύετο	he/she/it was being loosened
ἐλύόμεθα	we were being loosened
ἐλύεσθε	you (pl.) were being loosened
ἐλύοντο	they were being loosened

Adverbial καί -- "also" or "even"

- οὐ πιστεύεις ὅτι εἷς ἐστὶν ὁ θεός, καλῶς ποιεῖς· καὶ τὰ δαιμόνια πιστεύουσιν καὶ φρίσσοουσιν. (James 2:19)
- ἐλθέτω ἡ βασιλεία σου· γενηθήτω τὸ θέλημά σου, ὡς ἐν οὐρανῷ καὶ ἐπὶ γῆς·
(Matt 6:10, "Let your kingdom come, let your will be/happen/take place ① as in heaven and on earth; or ② as in heaven—even on earth." AWP)
 - ^{KRV} 나라이 임하옵시며 뜻이 하늘에서 이룬 것 같이 땅에서도 이루어지이다
 - ^{YLT} "Thy reign come: Thy will come to pass, as in heaven also on the earth.
 - ^{NIV} your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.
 - ^{NRS} Your kingdom come. Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.
